Product Description

PACRYLIC FINISH TOPCOAT is an acrylic resin-based finish paint which has an excellent outdoor durability, abrasion, and weathering resistance suitable for many substrates such as concrete cement, masonry surfaces and metal. It can be used for both interior and exterior applications. It is fast drying and gives good adhesion.

Typical Uses

PACRYLIC FINISH TOPCOAT is widely recommended for area properly primed, such as:

- Retaining walls, plastered wall.
- Pavement brick, concrete cement and masonry surfaces.
- Interior or exterior building.

Surface Preparation

Prior application of PACRYLIC FINISH TOPCOAT: -

New surface: Surfaces generally must be clean, dry and free of all loose, dirt, dust, grease, wax, oil stain and other contaminants before paint application. Surface affected by rust, fungus, algae and foreign matter must be thoroughly cleaned and primed with Protective Pacrylic Primer before finishing coat.

Painted surface: For a strong preceding coat, light sanding is recommended. Meanwhile for a weak preceding coat, total removal of the coat is highly recommended. Then surface must be thoroughly cleaned, dried and free of all loose, dirt, dust, oil stain and other contaminants before paint application.

Storage

The product must be kept in a cool, dry and well-ventilated place.

Health and Safety

Safety Precautions

Before use: Read instructions for use and precautionary labels on container.

During use: Avoid contact with skin. Ensure good ventilation during use and avoid inhalation of

spray, mist and fumes. Wear suitable respiratory or face mask. Wear suitable eye

protection. Avoid ingestion of paint.

Storage: Store away from heat and sources of ignition. Avoid prolonged exposure to vapors.

Disposal: Follow local and national regulations.

Spillage: Remove all sources of ignition. Avoid prolonged exposure to vapors. Clean up with

absorbent materials. Ventilate area. Do not wash into drains.

Emergency Treatment

Eyes: Flush immediately with water. Seek medical advice.

Skin: Remove contaminated clothing. Use a proprietary skin cleanser. Wash well with soap

and water.

Fire: Fight fire with foam or dry powder.

Inhalation: Remove into fresh air. Loosen collar and avoid excessive exertion.

Ingestion: Seek immediate medical advice. **DO NOT** induce vomiting.
